### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#### 1. Livery provider

Mares arriving for insemination and embryo transfer stay in livery in Klub Sportowy Nad Wigrami Sp.z.o.o., Mikołajewo 25A, 16-503 Krasnopol, under separate 'LIVERY CONTRACT'

#### 2. Breeding season

Breeding season starts on the 1st of March and finishes on the 30th of September. It is not possible to leave mares at the Stud outside of these dates. Livery fee for mares staying after the 30th of September will be charged at the rate of 200%.

#### 3. Artificial insemination

Instytut Rozrodu i Embriotransferu Koni (hereinafter referred to as IREK) offers artificial insemination with fresh and frozen semen of the stallion chosen by the owner/keeper of the mare (hereinafter referred to as Owner). Semen from abroad must be accompanied by TRACE Veterinary Health Papers and semen from a stallion stationed in Poland must be accompanied by a copy of 2019 laboratory results of tests for sexually transmitted diseases. IREK collaborates with Elite Stallions Poland ([www.elitestallions.pl](http://www.elitestallions.pl), see also [www.elitestallions.co.uk](http://www.elitestallions.co.uk)), a company that provides horse semen importing service from big number of stallions available in Europe.

#### 4. Embryo transfer

Mares arriving for embryo transfer (donors) are required to be tested for Equine Infectious Anaemia and Contagious Equine Metritis. These can be also done after mare's arrival at IREK. IREK has at its disposal a group of selected recipient mares. The owner of the donor mare may also bring their own recipient mares. In that situation however, IREK cannot guarantee that one of these mares will be used to transfer any embryos to, because their suitability depends on the synchronization, tone of the cervix and ultrasound picture of the reproduction tract on the day of transfer. IREK also offers a service where embryos are shipped from outside to be transferred into recipients. The service of embryo transfer is deemed completed when an embryo developing in a recipient mare is 45 days old. From that day onward the responsibility for the recipient mare and her pregnancy shifts to the client.

#### 5. Documents

Documents required with a mare arriving at IREK:

- 1) mare's passport
- 2) CONTRACT - MARE 2019
- 3) LIVERY AGREEMENT

Owner is required to fill and sign the forms when their mare first arrives at IREK. If the Owner is not present on the mare's arrival, they should print out the forms, fill and sign them and send together with the mare and her passport. It is a legal requirement that a horse should always be accompanied by its passport. Any mares arriving at IREK must have current vaccinations against Equine Influenza in the passport.

#### 6. Horses Health

All mares and foals arriving at IREK undergo brief clinical examination for signs of contagious diseases. Only healthy horses will be accepted. Horses showing following symptoms: lack of appetite, fever, anaemia, diarrhoea, enlarged lymph nodes, nose discharge, cough, poor body condition, ringworm, lice infestation will not be accepted at IREK because they may pose a risk of infection or infestation to other horses staying at the stud. If at the arrival any of the symptoms will be found, the horse will be sent back at the Owner's cost. If you notice any of the symptoms in your horse or horses staying at the same premises, please call us for advice before bringing your horse to IREK.

#### 7. Dangerous behaviour

IREK reserves the right to use a twitch or pharmacological sedation in purpose to restrain a horse without prior consultation with the Owner, as well as to refuse livery or veterinary service to any horse that they consider unacceptable risk to safety of other horses or staff.

#### 8. Items left with the horse

Mare should wear a light, well fitted headcollar which she will keep on all the time. IREK does not accept responsibility for items left with the horse. Please do not leave leadropes.

### 9. Hind shoes

Mares that are to go out on paddocks or pastures with other mares should arrive at the stud without hind-shoes.

### 10. Blacksmith

Horses staying at the stud will have their feet trimmed or shod as indicated by the Owner, by the blacksmith organised by the Owner or one that IREK cooperates with. Veterinary surgeon Aleksandra Jagusiak reserves the right to make a decision taking horse's welfare into consideration, to have horse's feet trimmed without prior consultation with the Owner. Blacksmith and handling costs will be charged to the Owner.

### 11. De-worming

Horses staying at the stud will be de-wormed as indicated by the Owner. Veterinary surgeon Aleksandra Jagusiak reserves the right to make a decision taking horse's welfare into consideration, to de-worm a horse without prior consultation with the Owner. Cost of de-worming product will be charged to the Owner.

### 12. Veterinary Work

All veterinary work concerning reproduction is undertaken by veterinary surgeon Aleksandra Jagusiak MRCVS, or, in exceptional circumstances, by a replacing veterinary surgeon. Many routine veterinary and stud procedures, like restraining in the stocks, rectal palpation, teasing, insemination, vaccinations, sedation, administration of any pharmacological products, is associated with small but inevitable risk to the horse. IREK endeavours to minimise that risk. In the event of emergency or accident IREK will aim, in the first place, to help and ease further suffering to the horse, in the second place, to contact the Owner. In the event that the Owner cannot be reached, IREK reserves the right to make decisions regarding the horse's welfare such as to call outside veterinary assistance, to transport the horse to equine hospital and to perform euthanasia. The Owner commits to cover any costs associated with IREK's or third party's work.

### 13. Responsibility

We endeavour that the stud is a safe place for both human and animals. Horses receive every possible care and supervision. However, IREK accepts no responsibility for accidents, theft, disease or damage to any horse, person or property, unless resulting from IREK's negligence or veterinary mistake. Please do not bring dogs to the stud and do not leave children without supervision.

### 14. Payments

Stud-fees must be paid before first insemination or semen dispatch. Costs of INSEMINATION PACKAGES and EMBRYO COLLECTION PACKAGE must be paid on arrival of the mare to IREK. Other costs are payable each time when the mare leaves IREK. Owners who send a third party to collect their horse must make arrangements to pay in advance of collection. Payments can be made with bank transfer or cash. We cannot accept credit or debit cards.

### 15. Not Intended For Human Consumption

In a horse passport there is a declaration that excludes the horse from human food chain, which the Owner can sign or leave unsigned. If the Owner signs the declaration, he/she makes the decision to exclude the horse from human consumption. This decision is irreversible and it has the advantage that a veterinary surgeon can administer any available medicines. Leaving the declaration unsigned gives an option to end the horse's life in slaughterhouse but greatly reduces the number of medicines that could be administered to the horse. This declaration can also be sign by a veterinary surgeon or another authorized person.

### 16. Privacy Policy

We use your data to provide the Service. By requiring the Service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy. ### PRICE-LIST

#### Livery

- mare without foal on pasture: 25,00 PLN/day (app. 6 EUR/day)
- mare without foal stabled: 30,00 PLN/day (app. 7 EUR/day)
- mare with foal: 35,00 PLN/day (app. 8 EUR/day)

#### Insemination packages

- insemination package - chilled semen: 800,00 PLN (195 EUR)  
The fee covers up to 3 cycles and includes all ultrasound scans (also for pregnancy), inseminations, as well as medicines used for cycle control, uterine wash-outs after insemination, Caslick surgery and twin pregnancy reduction. Does not include costs of laboratory tests, advanced diagnostic tests and subfertility treatment.  
The package includes a taxi fare from DHL depot in Białystok to IREK worth 300 PLN (73 EUR). This is because the address of IREK is not covered by the 'next day delivery' service for shipments from abroad. If second or further imports are necessary, the cost of 300 PLN will be charged to the Owner bill each time.
- insemination package - frozen semen: 1000,00 PLN (240 EUR)  
The fee covers up to 3 cycles and includes all ultrasound scans (also for pregnancy), inseminations (deep intrauterine), as well as medicines used for cycle control, uterine wash-outs after insemination, Caslick surgery and twin pregnancy reduction. Does not include costs of laboratory tests, advanced diagnostic tests and treatment.

#### Embryotransfer

- embryo collection package: 800,00 PLN (195 EUR)  
Includes synchronization of recipients, embryo collection procedure, embryo searching and embryo transfer to recipient mare.
- lease of recipient 45 days pregnant: 7 000,00 PLN (1700 EUR)  
Lease of recipient mare belonging to IREK for the time of pregnancy and foal rising, not longer however than March 2021. In the event that the embryo dies before pregnancy scan or within first 45 days of pregnancy the Owner does not pay this fee.  
Additionally, refundable deposit for the recipient mare is required: 7 000 PLN (1700 EUR)
- pregnancy 45 days in a recipient provided by the Owner: 3 000,00 PLN (730 EUR)  
In the event that the embryo dies before pregnancy scan or within first 45 days of pregnancy the Owner does not pay this fee.

#### Other services for mares:

- single ultrasound exam: 50,00 PLN (12 EUR)
- separate insemination: 50,00 PLN (12 EUR)
- collection of samples for laboratory tests and shipment to lab: 50,00 PLN (12 EUR)
- twin pregnancy reduction: 50,00 PLN (12 EUR) (included in the price is an exam 2-4 days later to confirm successful reduction)
- Caslick surgery : 50,00 PLN (12 EUR)

#### Other services:

- frozen semen storage outside the breeding season, up to 50 straws: 500,00 PLN (120 EUR)
- extra paperwork, per page 50,00 PLN (12 EUR)
- travel to client: 2 PLN/km (0,50 EUR/km)
